

NORTHAMPTON SAILING CLUB

Notice of Race for Navigators & General Mirror Nationwide Series & UK Junior Squad qualifier at Northampton SC At Pitsford Reservoir on Saturday 11th and Sunday 12th October 2014

The event will be classified Category "C" in accordance with RRS appendix 1.

The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, and the event supplementary sailing instructions. Under rule 87, rule 8 of the Internationals Mirror Class Rules will not apply. The boat can be sailed with one person on board for the regatta. Competitors should note that Northampton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.

Conditions of Entry: The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat, who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the sailing instructions, nor the inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor for his/her crew his/her boat and the management thereof.

The race organizers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid Third Party Liability Insurance with a minimum Cover of £3 million.

UKMCA Membership: Entrants must be fully paid up members of the UK Mirror Class Association. www.ukmirrorsailing.com. Forms will be available for Non-members to join on the day.

Entry Fee: £35 double handers / £25 single handers online entry. [Online Entry](#) is open until 9 pm on Wednesday October 8th 2014, after which time a late entry £45 & £35 respectively, (cheques made to "Mirror Class association" please) will apply. Entries and registration on the morning of the commencement of the racing from 09.30 hrs.
