



Notice of Race NEILPRYDE NATIONWIDE SERIES Event 2 Mirror Western Area Championships Looe Sailing Club

11th & 12th July 2015

Organising Authority: Looe Sailing Club.

Rules

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016.
- 1.2 The event will be designated category C in accordance with ISAF Reg.20
- **2 Eligibility and entry** Racing is open to any dinghy of the class which is racing on the date stated. Entries will be taken on the day of the regatta or may be made in advance or "on line". Both the helm and crew must be fully paid up members of the UK Mirror Class Association. OR Apply for membership of the UKMCA on the day.
- **3 Entry Fees** £40 online entry via Sailscore. Late entry £45, (cheques made to 'MCA' please). Entries and registration on the morning of the commencement of racing from 9.30.
- **4 Schedule of events** Racing will take place Looe Bay, Looe. The first signal will not be before 12.55 hours on the Saturday and not before 10.55 hours on the Sunday. Up to 6 races will be sailed over the event, with up to 4 races each day, at the discretion of the OOD. Briefing at 11.30 on Saturday.
- **5 Scoring** Races will be scored in accordance with the Racing Rules of Sailing (App A4 Low Points). The number of races to count will be as follows

6 races 5 to count

5 races 4 to count

4 races 3 to count

3 races 3 to count

2 races 2 to count

1 race 1 to count

- **6 Disclaimer of liability** Members and guests participate in club sailing entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Looe Sailing Club will not accept any liability for material damage, or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after any event.
- **7 Insurance** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least three million pounds for the event.
